Purpose



“...designed to improve students’ high school experience and reduce the state’s dropout rate.”

“...focuses on efforts to ensure students graduate ready for college or a career.”

Overview



Funding



- Direct funding to school districts
- \$800* per high school student per year
- Based on extended weighted average daily membership (ADMw)

Districts

- Must submit **biennial plan** for spending the money
- Report on progress toward targets in plan

*Amount may be adjusted.

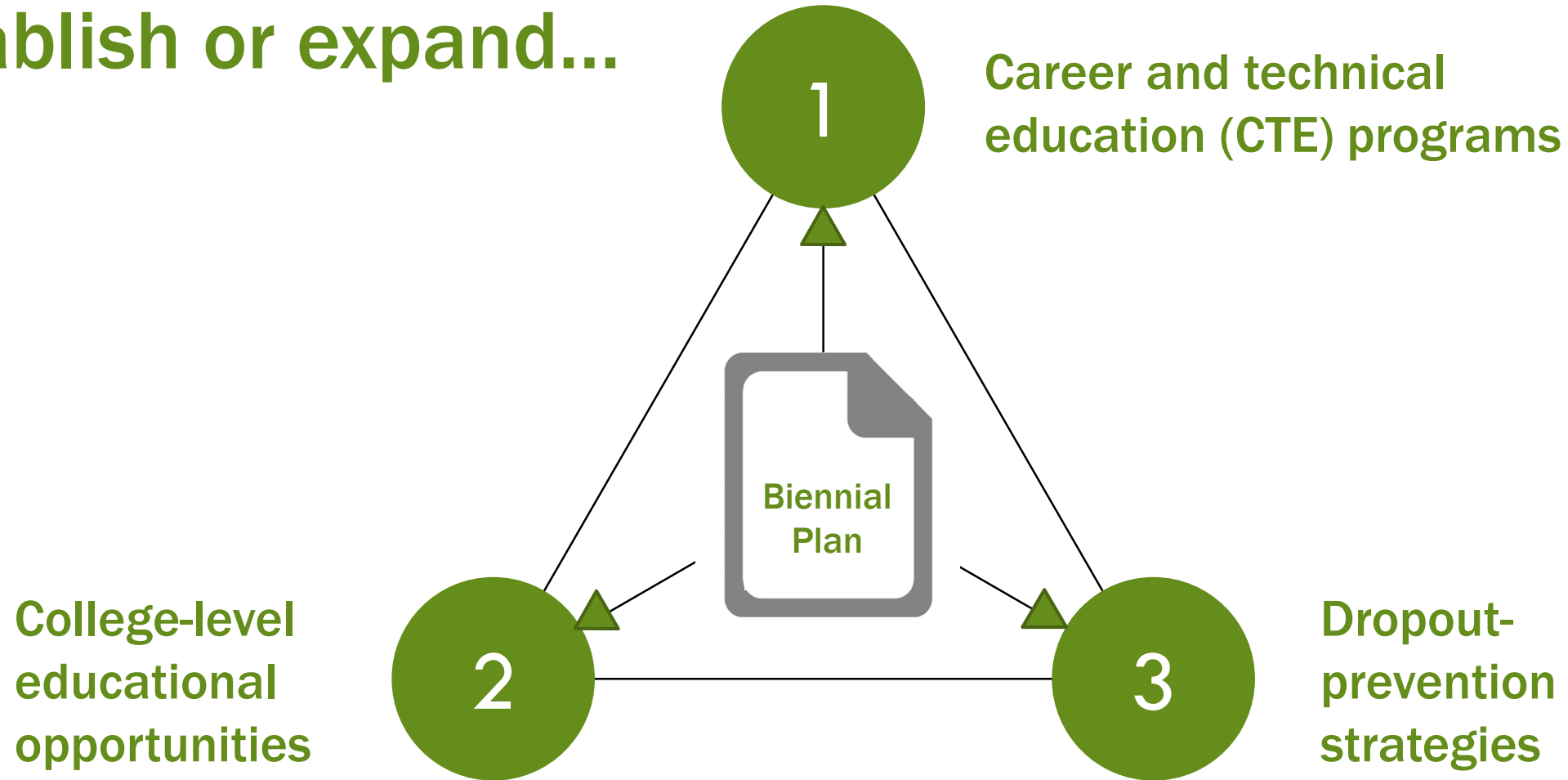

- Projected Funds Availability on 10/15/17

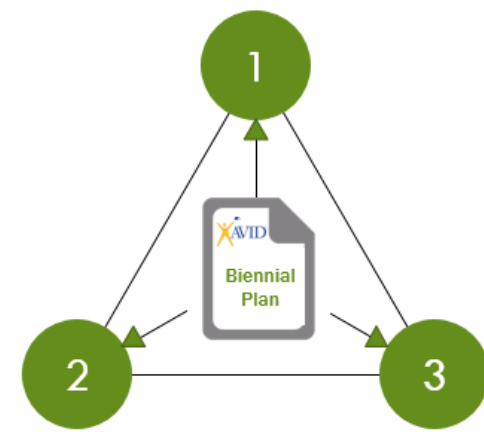

1 Career and technical education (CTE) programs

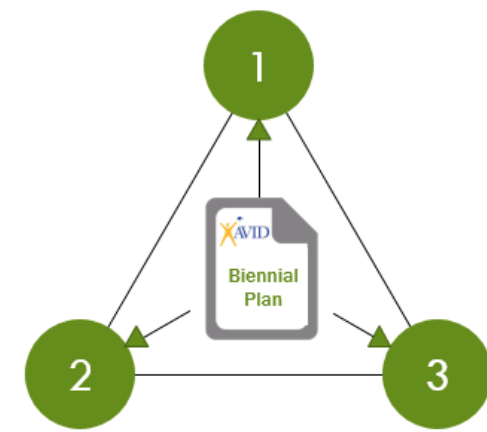
AVID supports CTE teachers and programs with rigorous teaching strategies so that students have the required writing, critical thinking, collaboration, and communication skills to succeed in their careers.

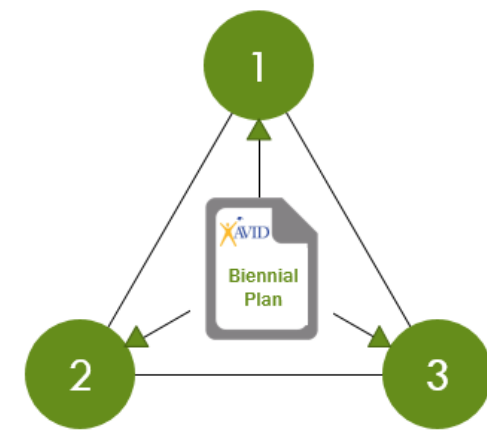

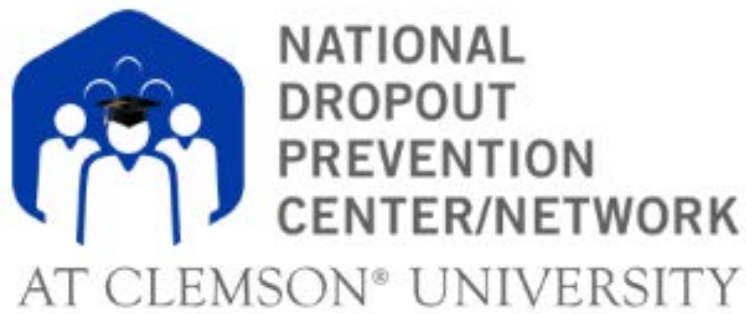

3 Dropout-prevention strategies

AVID is recognized as a **Model Program** by the National Dropout Prevention Center/Network.



Evaluation results showed:

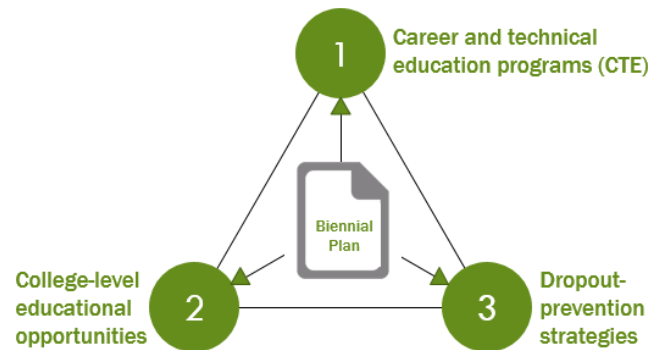
- Significant improvement in academic performance
- Increases in AP[®] course enrollment and completion
- Decreases in dropout rates
- Increases in college enrollment

AVID supports your plan...

- Include plans to establish or expand upon current efforts by the school district or charter school with evidence-based practices in three areas. (2e)



- Identify supports for teachers, counselors, and administrators to implement specific strategies. (2h)

- Identify resources and specific strategies for historically and traditionally marginalized students and historically underrepresented students and demonstrate what will be accomplished. (2g)

- Identify projections for disaggregated targets related to graduation, student participation in CTE and dual credit, advanced placement, International Baccalaureate, or comparable college-level courses, improvements in attendance, and student progress towards career pathways. (2i)

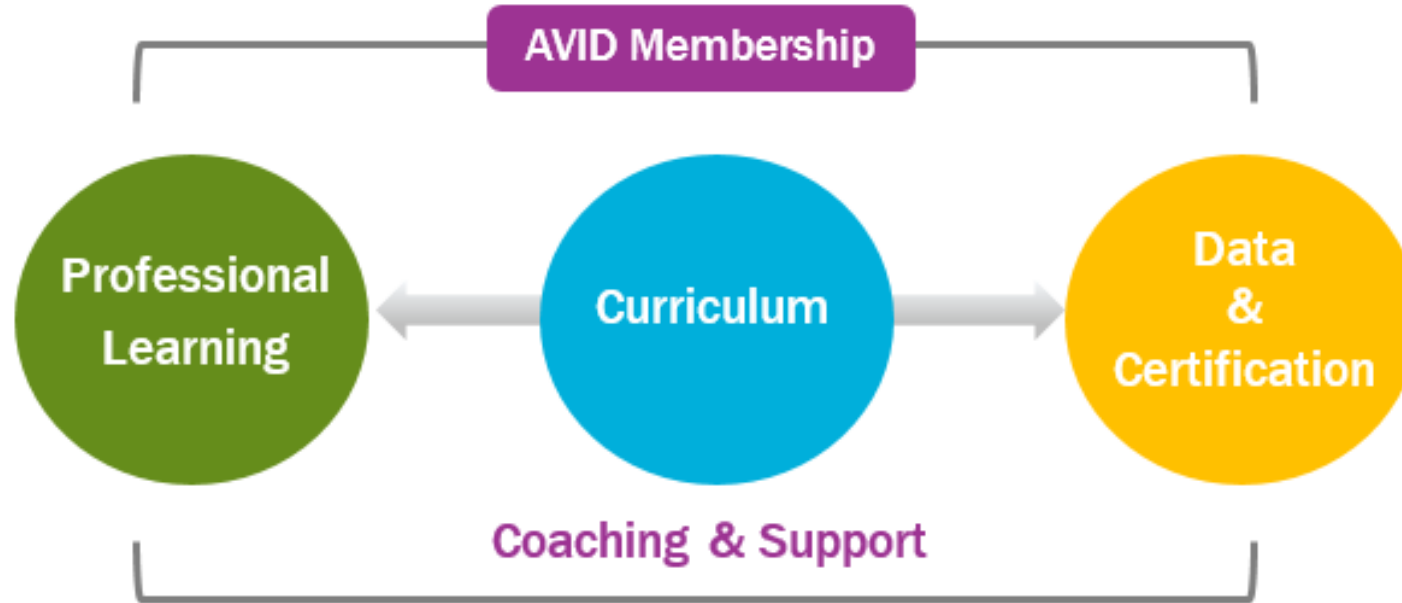

Start AVID and Reduce the Achievement Gap



2016 AVID Seniors in Oregon Completing Four-Year College Entrance Requirements



With AVID, all racial/ethnic groups in Oregon complete four-year college entrance requirements at a rate of **85% or higher**, closing the achievement gap.

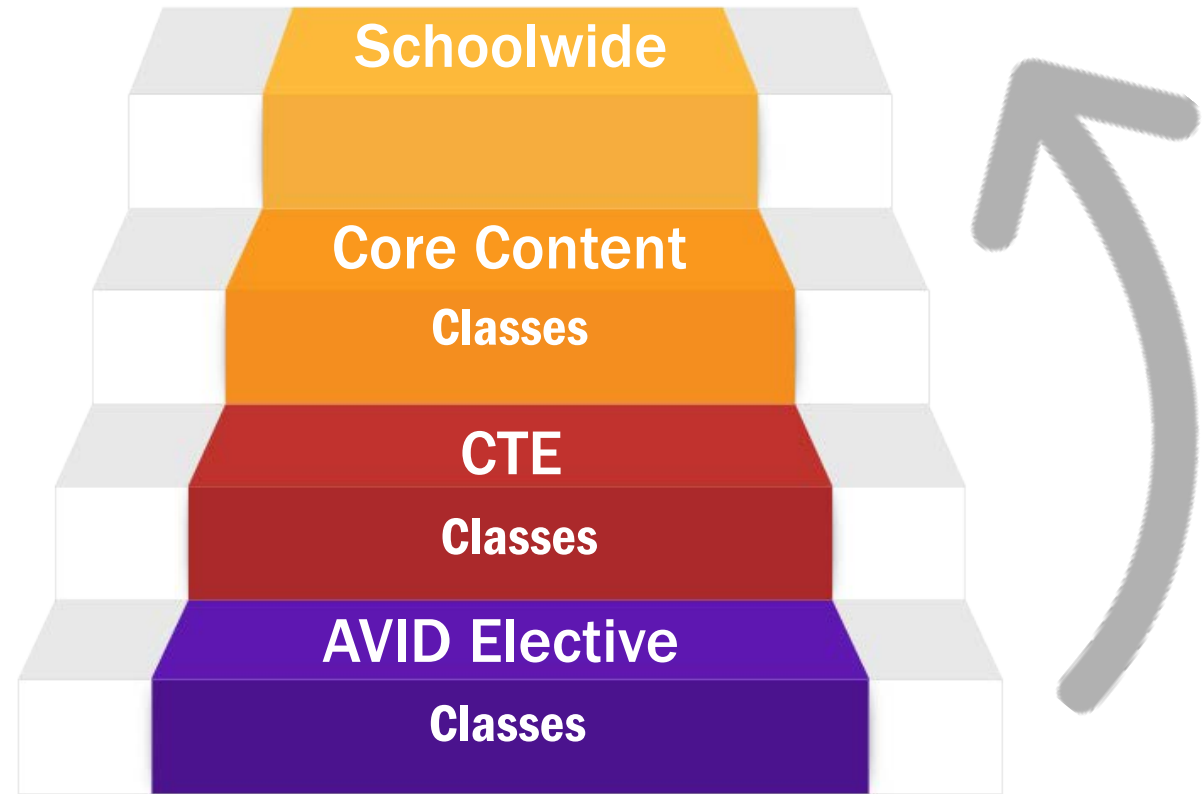
*Other includes American Indian or Alaska Native students, students of two or more races, and students who declined to state.

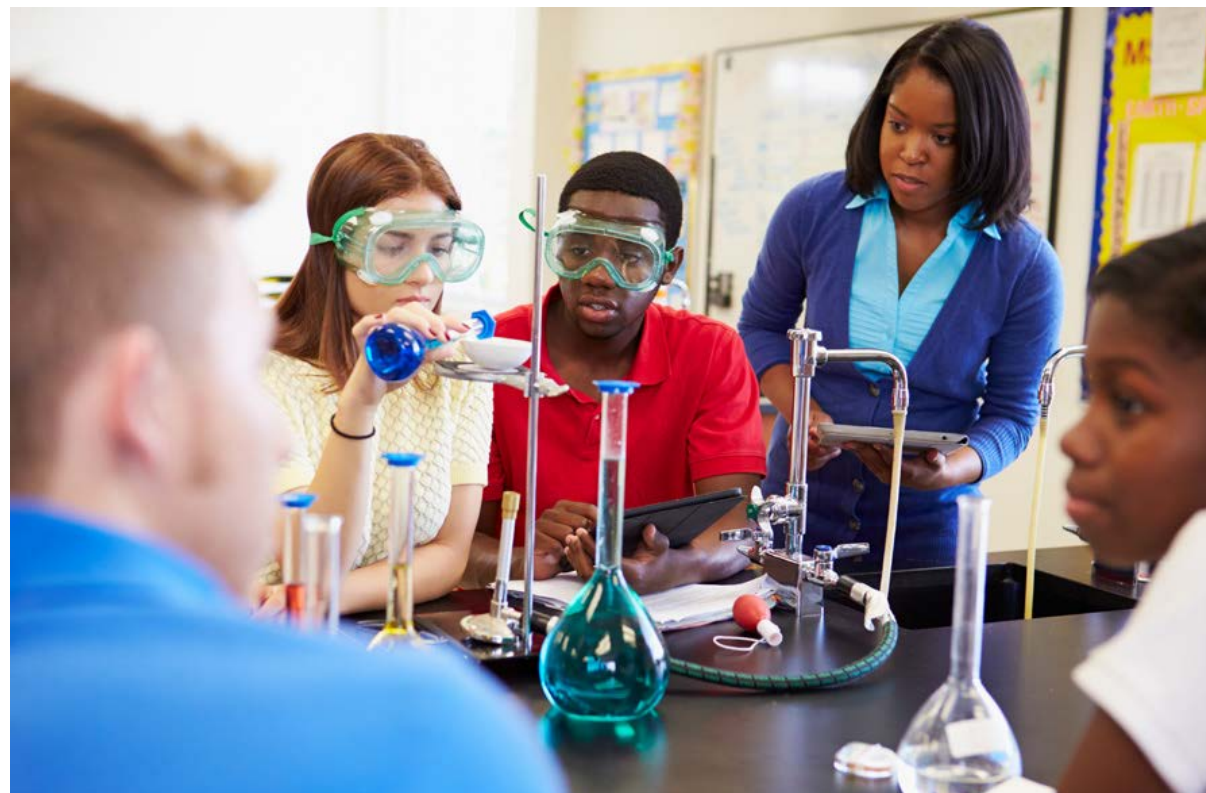


CTE Focus
