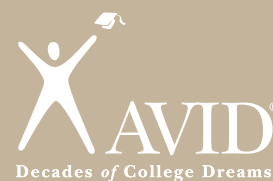

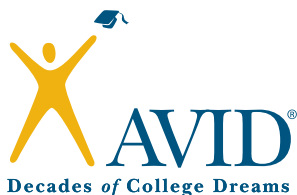
Hotel Information

Path Trainings

for AVID districts only

who should attend:

- Subject Area Teachers
- AVID Elective Teachers

description: Writing, inquiry, collaboration, and reading (WICR) strategies provide the framework for all training.

The Write Path training focuses on specific core subject areas including English language arts, English language learners, history/social science, math and science for high school and middle level teachers.

AVID Elective Teacher training is designed for those new to the AVID elective who have not had an opportunity to attend the AVID Summer Institute Implementation strand.

The Student Success Path training is designed for other middle level and high school teachers who do not teach core subject areas or the AVID elective. The content focuses on taking effective notes, working collaboratively, using planning calendars, and time logs.

ELL Science or ELL Math: Intended for 6-12 science or math teachers and ELL/ELD/ESL teachers. These specialized, hands-on, 2-day trainings lead teachers through a variety of AVID ELL strategies designed to engage all students but especially ELLs in science or math content. Teachers will use their understanding of language proficiency levels and production to integrate ELL strategies and to maximize lesson design in the math or science classroom.

* Path trainings, with the exception of AVID Elective Teacher training, will be cancelled if the minimum number of participants is not met. Deadline for registration is four weeks prior to the first day of the event. AVID Center strongly recommends participants wait 4 weeks prior to the training start date before making air travel arrangements.

Districts wanting their own Path trainings may contract with AVID Center.

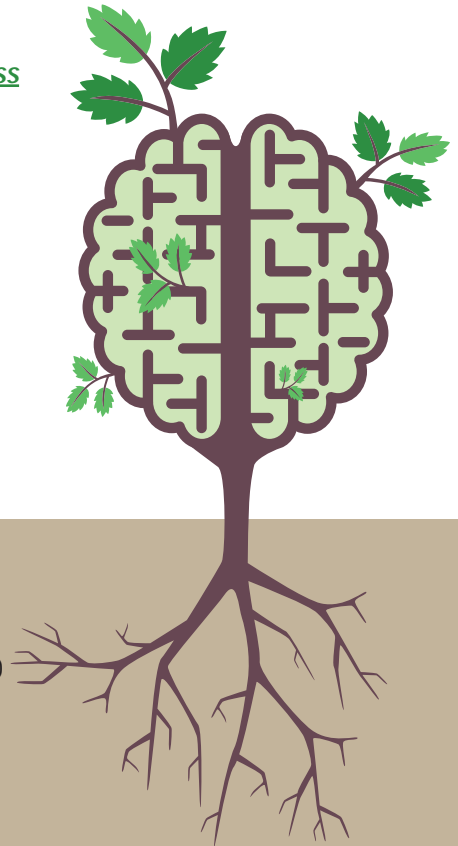
