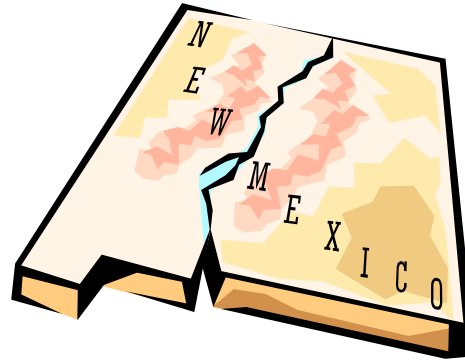


AVID first began in New Mexico in 2002. There are 11 districts on board for 2011-2012 with the AVID elective class offered in 50 secondary schools throughout the state.
