## 12 AVID WICOR Strategies that can be used with Nepris Sessions:

#### **Before**

- Students generate Costa's Levels of Thinking level 1, 2, and 3
  questions to ask the presenter (I)
- Students use the AVID Reading Process to critically read a text related to the content of the presentation (R)
- Students complete a Quickwrite to activate their thinking related to the content of the presentation **(W)**
- Students conduct research related to the content of the presentation (I)

### **During**

- Students take Focused notes during the presentation (W, O, R)
- Students create a Vocabulary Log of new vocabulary they heard during the presentation (W, R)
- The presenter utilizes a 10-2-2 presentation format, with 10 minutes of speaking, 2 minutes of collaborative processing and question-generating, 2 minutes of individual processing (I,C)
- Students utilize public speaking skills to ask questions of the presenter (C)

### **After**

- Students complete a learning log over the presentation (W)
- Students set goals of what they would need to do if they wanted to pursue the career field of the presenter **(O)**
- The teacher facilitates a Philosophical Chairs or Socratic Seminar related to the content of the presentation (C)
- Students organize their notes from Nepris presentations in a designated section of their binder **(O)**
