



Frequently Asked Questions

What is AVID Elementary Weekly?

AVID Elementary Weekly is a curriculum tool that helps teach critical reading skills based on strategies developed by AVID Center. It uses current newspaper articles, graphics, and photos to provide students with high-interest stories while exposing them to various writing styles. AVID Elementary Weekly can be successfully applied across all subject areas in a school. It is web-based and accessible 24 hours per day, 7 days per week.

How do I access AVID Elementary Weekly?

Every educator on the elementary campus with a MyAVID account will have access to AE Weekly. District Directors, Principals, or Site Administrators/AVID Coordinators can create a MyAVID account for additional educators on the site. Log in to My.AVID.org and click the blue My eLearning button.

How many user IDs do I get with a subscription?

All educators on subscribed campuses have access through MyAVID. A MyAVID account is required for access.

How long will we receive AVID Elementary Weekly?

AVID Elementary sites will have access to AE Weekly beginning September 1 and expiring June 30. Access will resume beginning the following September.

As a site, how do I know if my district is purchasing AVID Elementary Weekly?

All AVID Elementary educators receive access to AVID Elementary Weekly as long as membership is up-to-date.

How do I access AVID Elementary Weekly?
