



Frequently Asked Questions

What is AVID Weekly?

AVID Weekly is a curriculum tool to help teach critical reading skills based on strategies developed by AVID Center. It uses current newspaper articles and videos to provide students with high-interest stories while exposing them to various writing styles. AVID Weekly can be successfully applied across all subject areas in a school. It is web-based and accessible 24 hours per day, 7 days per week.

How do I access AVID Weekly?

Login credentials are sent to the Site Principal. Log in to [My.AVID.org](https://www.myavid.org) and click the blue My eLearning button.

How many user IDs do I get with a subscription?

All educators on subscribed campuses have access through MyAVID. A MyAVID account is required for access.

How long will we receive AVID Weekly?

AVID Weekly is included as part of the middle and high school libraries for one school year, beginning in September and expiring June 30. AVID National Demonstration Schools will receive AVID Weekly from September to June 30 for each year that they are validated as Demonstration Schools. Annual subscriptions will restart the following September for Demonstration Schools upon completion of the required paperwork.

Does AVID prorate the cost of AVID Weekly if we order or receive it midway through the year?

AVID does not prorate the cost of the subscription. Since it is web-based, all previous months' materials from the current school year are archived and accessible to active users.

What if a school no longer wants AVID Weekly?

Secondary sites may opt out of AVID Weekly on their Contract and Quote Request by unchecking the AVID Weekly box for that site.

Please note, if one site in a district opts out of ordering AVID Weekly, then the remaining sites will not be eligible for the district discount.

Do districts have to opt out every year?

Yes, even if a site has previously opted out, each year the Contract and Quote Request will have AVID Weekly automatically checked for the secondary sites.

Are AVID National Demonstration Schools automatically opted out?

They are not opted out. When districts submit their Contract Request, they note which schools are National Demonstration Schools. Once verified by AVID, they will zero out the AVID Weekly cost for that particular site on the quote. The AVID Schoolwide team notifies the DD at beginning of each school year via email.

If my district doesn't order AVID Weekly on our contract, can I order it for my school?

Any contracted AVID site can order AVID Weekly a la carte by emailing orders@avid.org.
