





AVID Senior Demographics – Class of 2017

Low Socioeconomic Status Background




Parents Have No College Experience

AVID Seniors' Race/Ethnicity - Class of 2017




A majority of AVID students are of a race/ethnicity under-represented in higher education.

Nearly 6 out of every 10 AVID students have parents with no college experience, giving them little guidance in navigating the college readiness process.
