

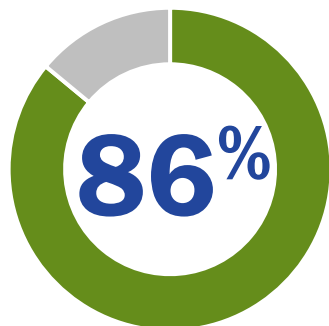

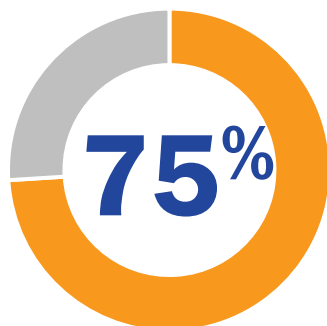

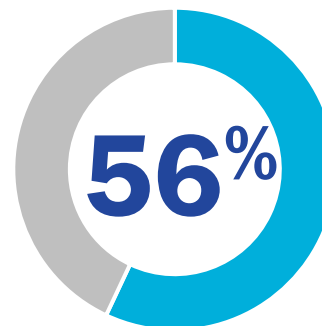
AVID Senior Demographics – Class of 2017

Race/Ethnicity**



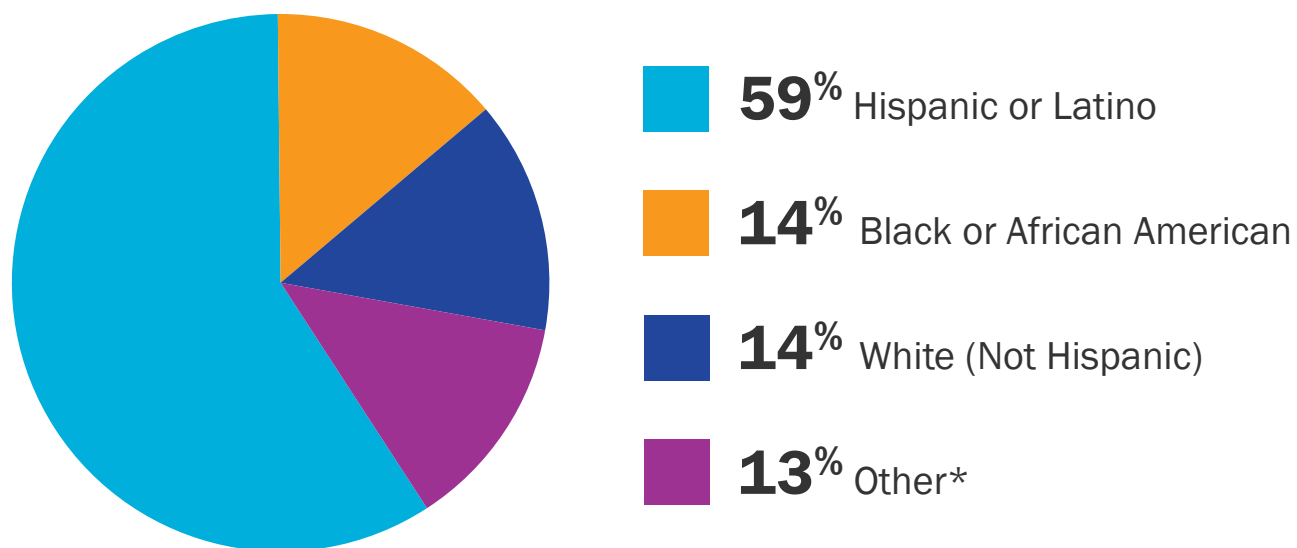
**Low Socioeconomic

AVID students often come from a more **challenged, disadvantaged background.**

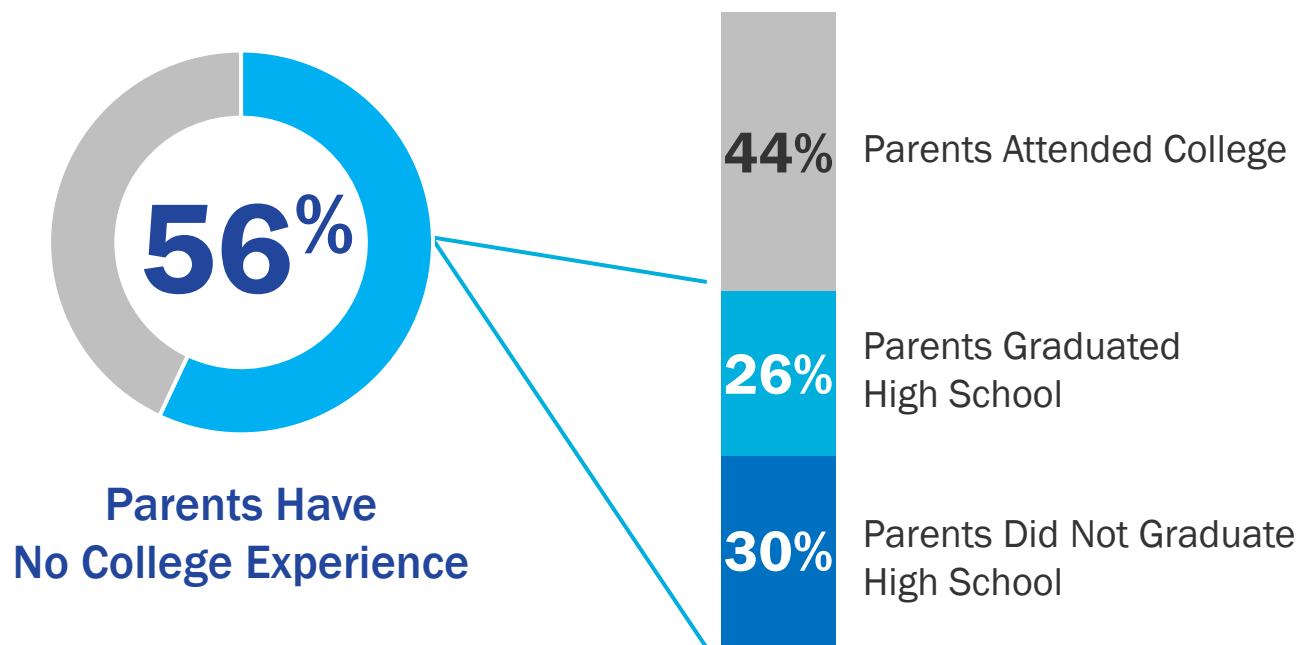
AVID Seniors' Race/Ethnicity – Class of 2017

Nearly **6 out of every 10** AVID students have parents with no college experience, giving them little guidance in navigating the college readiness process.
