



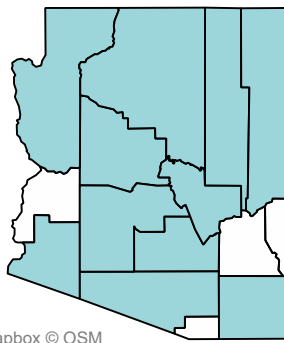
# Arizona SNAPSHOT

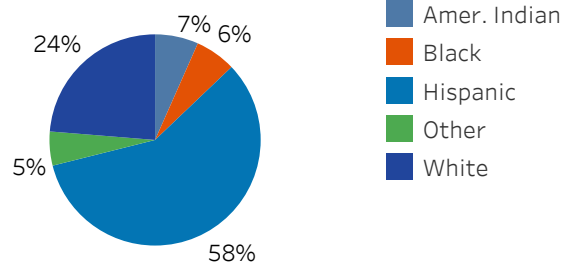
