

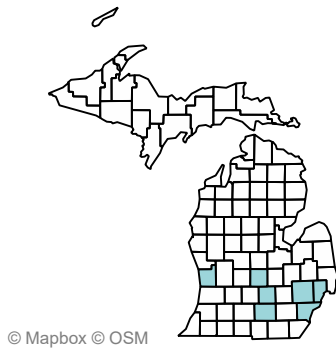


Michigan SNAPSHOT

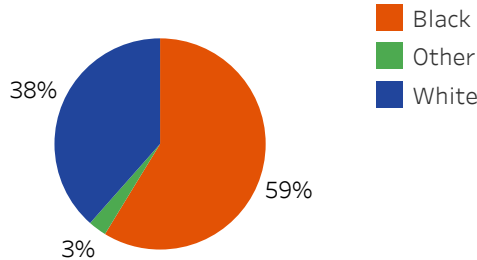
