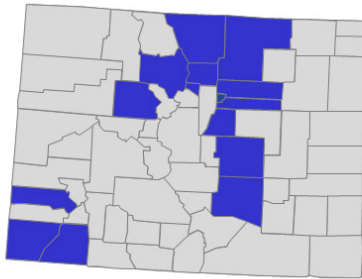

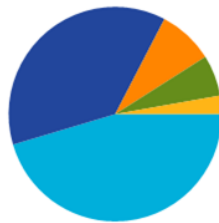

AVID National Demonstration Schools



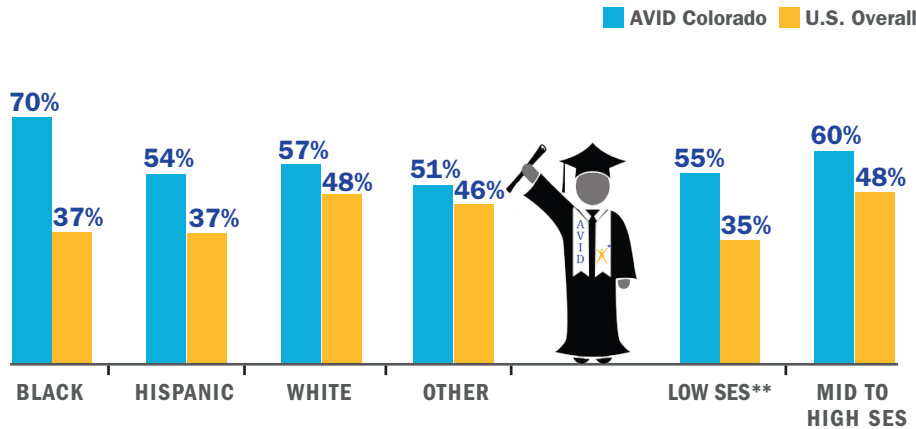

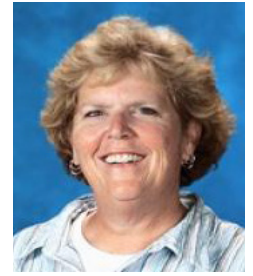
AVID Colorado – Closing the Achievement Gap for College Enrollment

AVID Colorado seniors are enrolling at more consistent rates between major subgroups than the U.S. population overall.



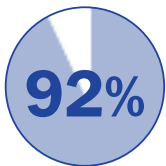
