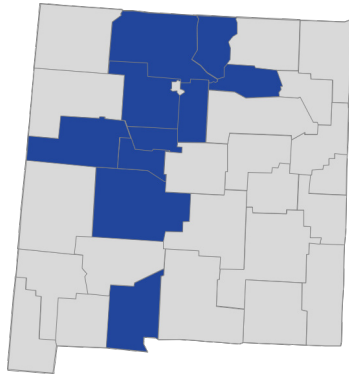

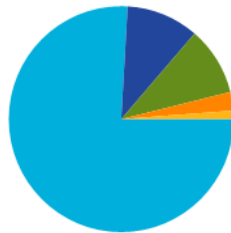

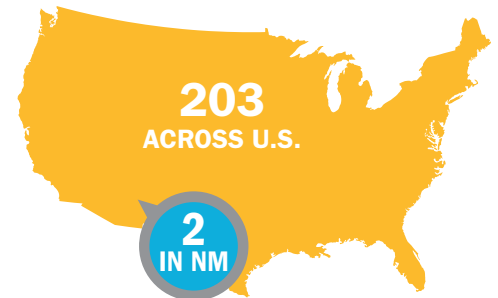
### Race/Ethnic Identity

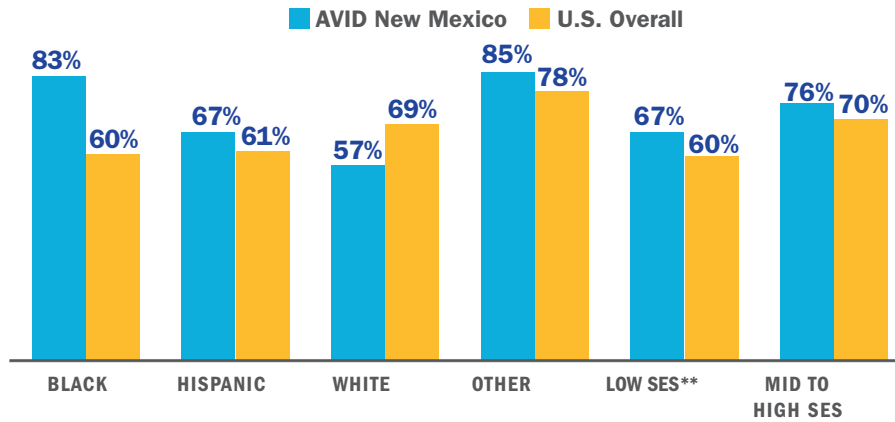
