

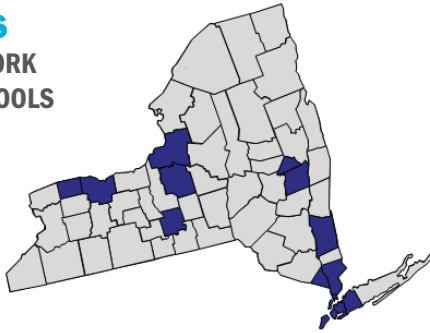
## AVID, Advancement Via Individual Determination,

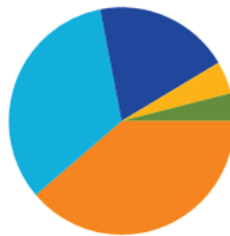

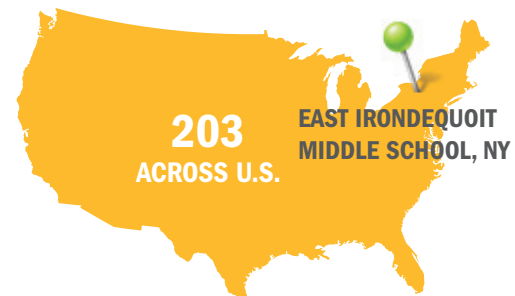

## AVID National Demonstration Schools



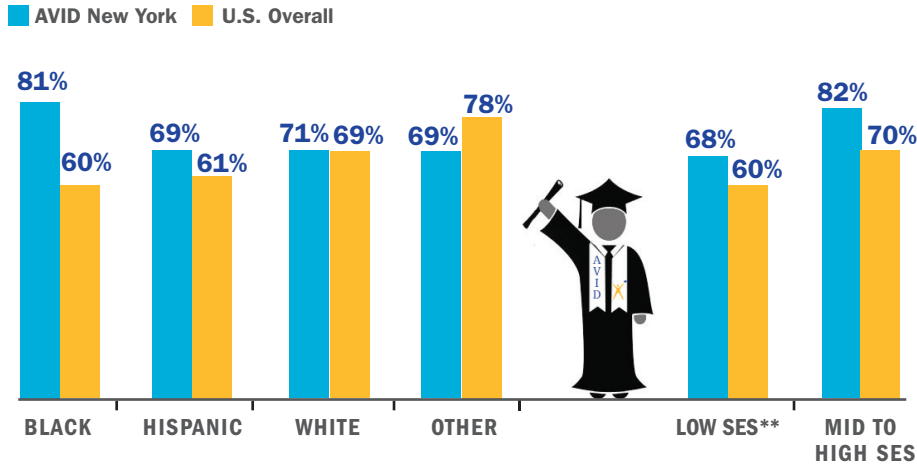

AVID New York seniors are enrolling at more consistent rates between major subgroups than the U.S. population overall.



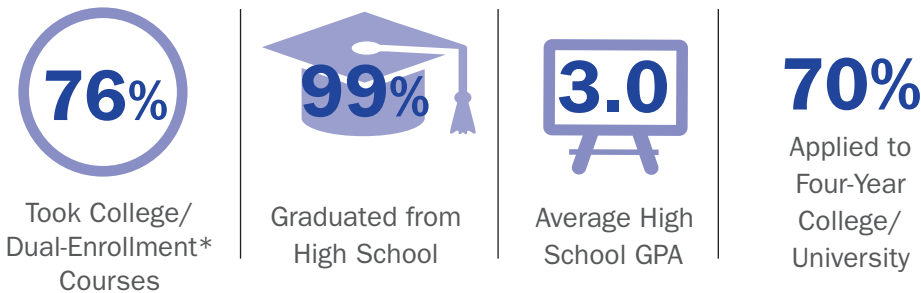
