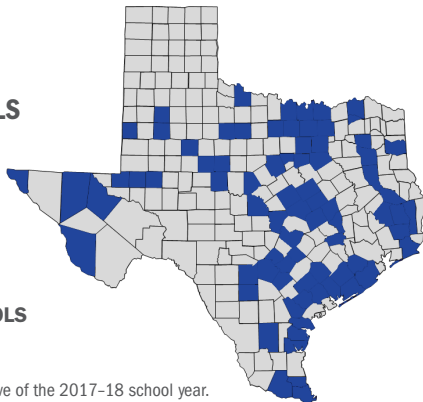


## AVID, Advancement Via Individual Determination,

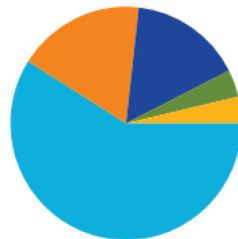

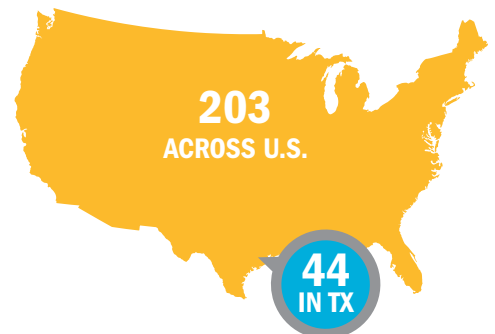

### AVID National Demonstration Schools



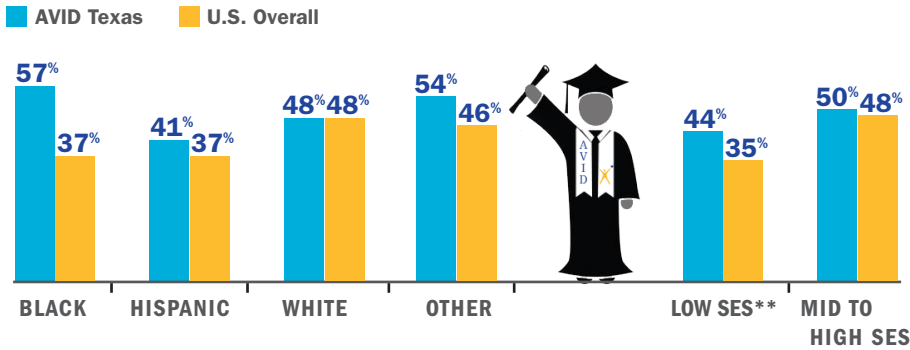

AVID Texas seniors are enrolling at consistent rates among most major subgroups compared to the population overall.



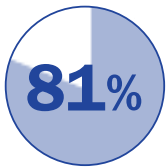
